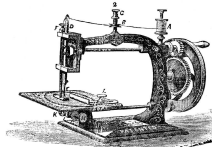

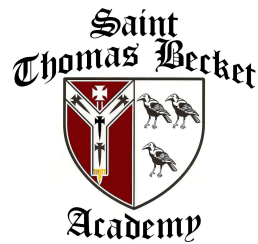

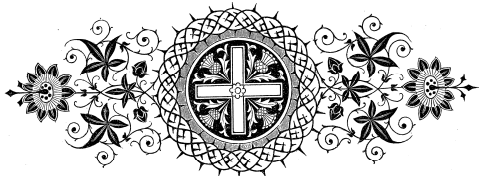
NEWS AND UPDATES
