

PERPETUAL LIGHT
POPE FRANCIS PROCLAIMS 2021
“YEAR OF ST JOSEPH”

With the Apostolic Letter “Patris corde” (“With a Father’s Heart”), Pope Francis recalls the 150th anniversary of the declaration of Saint Joseph as Patron of the Universal Church. To mark the occasion, the Holy Father has proclaimed a “Year of Saint Joseph” from today, 8 December 2020, to 8 December 2021.

During the year we are hoping to keep a ‘Perpetual Light’ of two candles, on St. Joseph’s altar to next December 8th. Those of you who are desirous in helping to keep these candles lit, are asked to donate \$2.00 / candle in honor of St. Joseph. An intention and donation card (*available in the vestibule*) with your donation can be placed in the regular Sunday donation envelope (please mark other) This card, with your intention, will be placed on St. Joseph’s altar during for one month.
