
FIRST FRIDAY

WHY DID ABP. LEFEBVRE CHOOSE ST. PIUS X?

In the early 1970s, the cradle years of the Society of St. Pius X (SSPX), the name of St. Pius V was on the lips of traditional Catholics throughout the world who were diligently building or converting barns into chapels for celebrating the Mass of St. Pius V, i.e., the Tridentine Mass. St. Pius V's name was so prevalent that it soon became clear that "the whole struggle between Ecône and Rome hanged on the Mass of all times."

However, Archbishop Lefebvre, when founding the Society, clearly mentioned St. Pius X in his statutes and couched his reasons on paper. The Archbishop explained that the purpose of the SSPX's activities is "[a]ll the works necessary for the formation of priests and whatever pertains thereto." The seminaries must take care that their training "attain its chief goal: **the priest's holiness, together with sufficient knowledge.**" This is why the Society was placed under the patronage of St. Pius X: the primordial concern of this holy Pope was the integrity of the priesthood and the sanctity that flowed from it.

Pius X was an Apostolic Pope who was able to keep in check the most deadly heresy the Church has ever endured, Modernism. This aspect, perhaps above all others, explains the choice of Giuseppe Sarto as the patron saint for the Archbishop's Society.

From Pope Pius X's 1st encyclical "E Supremi Apostolatus": "We do not wish to be, and with the Divine assistance never shall be anything but the Minister of God, of whose authority We are the depositary. The interests of God shall be Our interest, and for these We are resolved to spend all Our strength and Our very life. Hence, should anyone ask Us for a symbol as the expression of Our will, We will give this and no other: **"To renew all things in Christ."** ..."

"The desire for peace is certainly harbored in every breast, and there is no one who does not ardently invoke it. But to want peace without God is an absurdity, seeing that where God is absent thence too justice flies, and when justice is taken away it is vain to cherish the hope of peace. "Peace is the work of justice" (Is. xxii., 17). There are many, We are well aware, who, in their yearning for peace, that is for the tranquility of order, band themselves into societies and parties, which they style parties of order. Hope and labor lost, for there is but one party of order capable of restoring peace in the midst of all this turmoil, and that is the party of God. It is this party, therefore, that we must advance, and to it attract as many as possible, if we are really urged by the love of peace..."

"Yet who can fail to see, Venerable Brethren, that while men are led by reason and liberty, the principal way to restore the empire of God in their souls is religious instruction? How many there are who mimic Christ and abhor the Church and the Gospel more through ignorance than through badness of mind, of whom it may well be said: "They blaspheme whatever things they know not" (Jude ii., 10). This is found to be the case not only among the people at large and among the lowest classes, who are thus easily led astray, but even among the more cultivated and among those endowed moreover with uncommon education. The result is for a great many the loss of the faith. For it is not true that the progress of knowledge extinguishes the faith; rather is it ignorance, and the more ignorance prevails the greater is the havoc wrought by incredulity. And this is why Christ commanded the Apostles: "Going forth teach all nations" (Matth. xxvii., 19)."
