The Wednesday High School Catechism classes will resume in the fall. These classes are for those High-School students who do not go to a Catholic School.

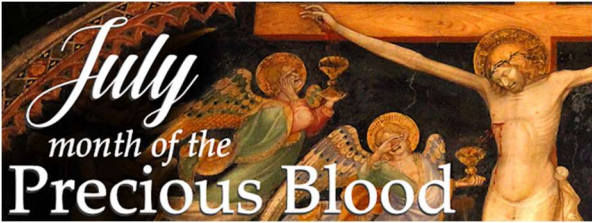
REGARDING RETREATS
