St. Thomas Becket, the outpost of the Society of St. Pius X in the Pacific Northwest! With the recent Motu Proprio, Traditionis Custodes, the necessity of the Society has been reaffirmed in 2021 and our priories like St. Thomas Becket. Back in 2007, Pope Benedict XVI stated in his Motu Proprio, Summorum Pontificum, that the Tridentine Mass had never been abrogated. All it did was reaffirm the position of our holy founder, Archbishop Marcel Lefebvre, who in the mid-1970's continued to say this Mass in spite of all threats leveled against him. It took a man of great courage...and sanctity to continue on this path as virtually the whole modern Church was against him. Very few of the clergy supported him; but in spite of this, the Society continued to grow.

In 1988, since there was no guarantee that his Order would be truly protected by the modern Churches authorities, the Archbishop consecrated four bishops to continue to work of the Society, especially in its fight against modernism and liberalism. The attacks on his Fraternity began anew. But the work went on .....and continued to grow. Our saintly founder would go to his heavenly reward on March 25th, 1991.

In 2007, coming especially from a request of the Society, the Pope liberated the Tridentine Mass for any priest to celebrate, and that it was never abrogated, was also surprisingly confirmed in the document. The Archbishop was vindicated, ever so slightly. The last fourteen years has seen an immense growth of the celebration of this Mass, and also of communities devoted to the Tridentine Mass. It has been especially impressive since the Tridentine Mass does not have the zealous backing of the modern Church- has it not been called the "Extraordinary Form" since 2007?

But there has been a deeper problem which has existed all along- going back to 1965, the problem of Vatican Council II. All those Latin Mass communities have had a serious dilemma of more or less avoiding the issue. The Society of St. Pius X has demanded from the beginning in its fight with modern Rome that the controversial Council texts be re-examined and changed so that there can ONLY be a Catholic interpretation of them. We are still in a stalemate at the present moment. Hopefully, this new attack on the Mass will enlighten people of the real fight that has gone on now for over 55 years! This is where the real fight truly is. It cannot be ignored. It cannot be brushed aside. Silence towards it only continues the problem! More people are beginning to see it, but still there is still only a small number- but growing.

In spite of this new Motu Proprio, the SSPX goes on with its work here in Veneta. From Fr. Eugene Heidt, to its Priors Fr. Lawrence Novak, Fr. Daniel Cooper, Fr. Trevor Burfitt, Fr. John Brucciani, Fr. Stephen Stanich, and now Fr. Shane Pezzutti, our work remains the same, that of saving souls and as our rule says, "Sanctifying the priesthood and everything that surrounds it". We ask for your continued zealous support of our Order. May we be a light amidst the so much darkness of our times. St. Pius X, pray for us!
