The Society has three retreat houses here in America. A retreat is an excellent opportunity to get away from the world to consider the truths of our salvation.



2021 PRIESTLY ORDINATIONS

MORE NEWS AND UPDATES

REGARDING LAYMEN’S RUBRICS FOR MASS
Fr. J. O’Connell (a famous rubricist) in his book ‘*Celebration of the Mass*’ published in 1940, lays out some of the suggested rubrics for laymen at a High Mass. Here are a few guidelines:



- All faithful kneel for the prayers at the foot of the altar up to the ‘Oremus’ and stand when the celebrant ascend the altar steps.
- During the ‘Sanctus’ all should remain standing until the ‘Sanctus’ has been sung, then all should kneel.
- After the ‘Pater Noster’ all remain standing until celebrant received the Precious Blood (i.e., or until the Agnus Dei has been completed by the choir).
